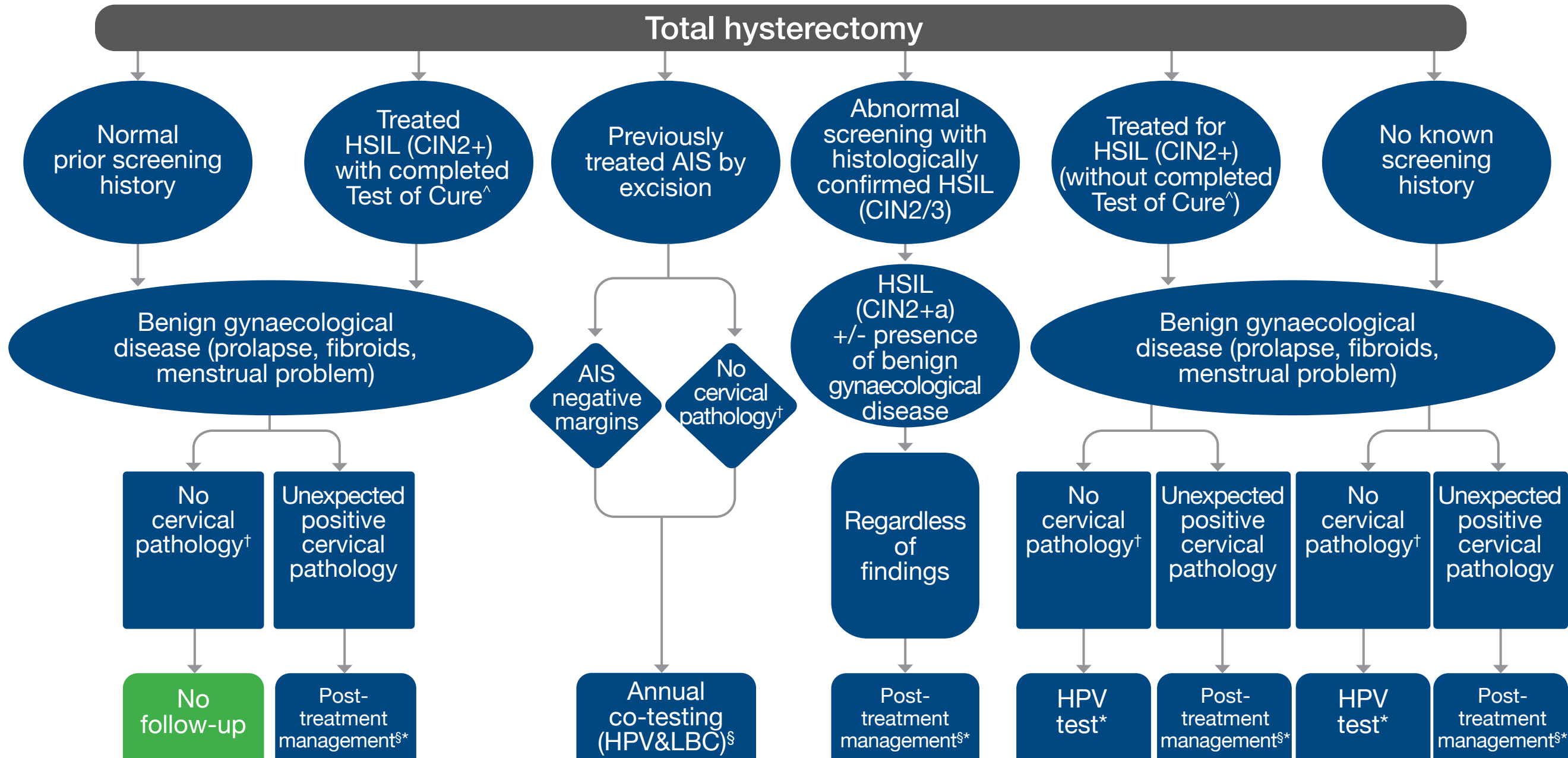


VAGINAL SCREENING AFTER TOTAL HYSTERECTOMY



^ completed Test of Cure, either with two consecutive annual rounds of negative co-tests or two consecutive annual rounds of negative HPV tests

† No cervical pathology (LSIL, HSIL or AIS) found on examination of the cervix

§ Post-treatment management for AIS in people with a hysterectomy: annual co-testing on a vaginal vault specimen is recommended, commencing 12 months after treatment until the person has tested negative on both tests (HPV and LBC) on 2 consecutive occasions, after which they do not need further testing

* Post-treatment management for HSIL or where no known screening history HPV test to be taken from the vaginal vault 12 months after treatment & annually thereafter until the person has tested negative on 2 consecutive occasions, after which they do not need further testing
